NB : Students who are candidates for both the program with Columbia University and with Cornell University must complete two separate applications. However, the letters of reference, sent directly to the Professor in charge of the program, may be written in a single copy.

The application includes:

- 1.** The third page of this leaflet, filled completely and carefully;
- 2.** An application letter (handwritten or typed) motivated in English, explaining your interest in the program;
- 3.** An up-to-date email address so that we can contact you easily. We will only communicate information via emails;
- 4.** Documents relating to the grades obtained by the candidate. These documents, photocopied, should focus on the current year and the two precedent years. They include:
 - The Baccalaureat transcript of grades
 - The transcript of grades obtained during the past two or three years (you may currently be in your 3rd or 4th year of study in French law).
- 5.** TOEFL Score : over 100 points is requested;
- 6.** Two recommendations : from Professors with whom the candidate has studied or from supervisors of former internship/job. Such letters shall be submitted using the attached sheets (page 4), and returned directly to Sophie Robin-Olivier, Professor in charge of the double degree program.
